## THE ROLE OF A FIELD OFFICER (FO)

FOs are required from May until October. The minimum stay is three consecutive weeks. FOs must be sociable, as they will be expected to work and live as part of a team of up to 12 people with shared cooking and cleaning duties. Unfortunately, this is not a paid position; FOs must organize and pay for their transport to Ischia and their meals. Accommodation (onboard) and insurance are provided by Oceanomare Delphis APS. FOs will be based on board the research vessel Jean Gab for the entire period.

All candidates are actively invited to carefully and thoroughly read the Oceanomare Delphis APS webpage (www.oceanomaredelphis.org), and the informative for volunteers to better understand how life on board is going to be and the type of activities and duties you will be requested to do.




